



ARGOS WHISKY RACE

All started with a strange idea, in what to use to build a rocket.
What is better suited than the tube, in which Whisky bottle are sold?

So the idea to set up a Drag Race using Rockets build with Whisky tubes did arise.

Here the rules:

- The tube to be used is the one of 1 liter Whisky bottle
- the "nosecone" is the original flat cover used on the Tube. (so basically no Nosecone)
- the MMT can be of whatever size you prefer

There are 2 motor rules:

- the motor case size is fixed: Aerotech 29 mm 180 Ns (AT 29/180)
- the igniter will be supplied at RSO table, for all flyers the same:
AT Copperhead.

It may be prepared and measured but must not be altered in any way.

- The rocket must have 2 rail buttons for launching (Blacksky standard, small size)
- The Tripoli rules in building HPR rockets are always to be respected
- The rocket, as usual, will be checked before the flight by a RSO, so you should get a CP/CG print out on hands while flying.

Time of the race: ALRS XII, in Val-De-Ruz

For setting up the proper launch infrastructure, we need to know how many flyers we will have.
